






- Animation for freshmen is permitted, with teacher approval.



 Wheel throwing is a part of Ceramics, but not the whole program.






- Photography includes Film and Digital photography.







All music classes, except Primo Orchestra require an audition before placement. Orchestra is for everyone, no previous experience necessary.



Involvement in the after school program is not required for any Theatre classes, but strongly encouraged!

- Different material is taught in each theatre and tech theatre level, and Tech 3, 4 and Theatre 3, 4 are all weighted as honors classes.
- Theatre 1 Covers the basics of theatre, voice and body techniques, early theatre history, intro to performance
- Theatre 2 Students dive deeper into theatre history and explore advanced performances topics
- Theatre 3 & 4 2 year rotating curriculum, students write and direct their own short plays, explore global theatre styles and periods of theatre history, and hone their acting skills
- Tech 1 Students learn the basics of all areas of technical theatre: management, set building, costuming, hair & makeup, lighting, sound, and props
- Tech 2 Students identify areas of interest and dive deeper while working on the fall and spring productions
- Tech 3 & 4 Technicians work in their area of interest as crew leads
