

- Restorative justice


Multi Tiered Systems of Support Administrator:

Frequently Asked Questions







Who gets a locker?

- 9th & 10th graders are assigned a locker
- 11th and 12th graders by request
- Locker assignments given within the first two weeks
- All backpacks and bags must be locked in a locker during PE class







Is Service Learning required?

- There are no set hours for Service Learning as a graduation requirement
- If students are interested in receiving a Service Learning Cord, then they must complete 40 hours of service which is logged in x2Vol
- Training to be held during Advisory class (LS4) in the fall





Is there a Supply List? What about Textbooks?

- Supply lists by class will be provided by curriculum team (Example: Geometry) and posted on the WSHS website
- Textbooks, if used, will be issued the first few weeks of school
- 1:1 technology: All students will be issued a laptop
