Expectations of 9th Graders:

AP Human Geography:

- What is it?
 - o Its more than WHERE places are. It's the <u>WHY and HOW</u> of humans changing the surface of the Earth!
- An introductory college level class
- Advised to have a B+ or higher in 7th & 8th grade
 BOTH Social Studies and English courses.
- Advised to have passed advanced English and Social Studies SOLs/Performance based assessments.
- Student should be able to:
 - Reading non-textbook sources both inside and outside of class including news articles, journal articles, etc. that are of a college reading level.
 - o Engage in **effective class discussion** both with instructor and peers.
 - o **Apply content** learned to real world scenarios.
 - Independently research and apply it to learned content.
- Expectations of completing homework assigned nearly nightly averaging 30-45 minutes.
- +1.0 GPA bump received at end of year.
- Students earn verified credit upon earning a 2 of higher (out of 5) on the AP exam.

Honors World 1:

- Advised to have a B+ or higher in 7th & 8th grade
 BOTH Social Studies and English courses.
- Advised to have passed advanced English and Social Studies SOLs/Performance based assessments.
- Expectations of reading and writing performed <u>both</u> inside and outside of class that are of higher rigor and length than standard history
- Student should be able to:
 - Successfully write a claim (or thesis) statement and support it in more than one paragraph.
 - Independently read and answer questions on multi-page articles and sources.
- The honors curriculum includes challenging primary and secondary sources, requiring the development of analytical skills.
- Willingness to perform multiple projects and be a frequent contributor to class discussion.
- Possess time management skills that allow for successful completion of several tasks over extended time frames both in class and at home.
- Expectation of completing homework assigned nightly, averaging roughly 30-45 minutes per period.
- Exhibits a high interest in Social Studies classes
- +.5 GPA bump received at end of year.
- Students earn verified credit by completing 3
 Performance Based Assessments throughout the year.

Standard World 1:

- Expectation of nightly homework averaging roughly 15-30 minutes of homework per class period.
- 1 writing assignment per quarter starting with greater support ending with independence.
- In class projects required both independent work and collaboration.
- No GPA bump is available at this level.
- Students earn verified credit by completing 3 Performance Based Assessments throughout the year.
