### 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents& Students:

In accordance with FCPS Policy 1802, FCPS students can apply for the position of Student Representative to the School Board. The student representative is not a member of the School Board but serves in a nonvoting, advisory capacity, representing the interests of the students of Fairfax County Public Schools. Students who are currently in grades 9, 10, and 11 are eligible to apply, and they do not need to be current members of the Superintendent's Student Advisory Council (SAC).

Applications are due March 23, 2022 at noon. The application and related details can be found here.

#### All Parents & Students:

In person at West Springfield High School on Saturday, March 12<sup>th</sup> from 1-3pm & Chantilly HS on Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup> from 11am-1pm. Local businesses are eager to hire. While most job seekers attending the fair are between ages 16 to 18, limited opportunities are sometimes available for students as young as 14. Job opportunities at the fair include full-time, part-time, seasonal, volunteer, and internship opportunities. In addition to job opportunities at the fair, students will also be able to attend a career-building workshop, like a Resume Workshop and Interviewing 101.

The best part of this fair is that it is completely FREE. For students, you simply register here. There is no requirement to be a resident or student in Fairfax County, although the opportunities at the fair will be based in Fairfax County. For more information on the fairs, you can visit here.

## **Scholarships**

(WSHS Specific) Rob Benton & Ron Tugwell Scholarship is now open! The West Springfield High School Athletic Boosters awards scholarships to WSHS graduating seniors who participated in a Virginia High School League (VHSL) sanctioned event or FCPS supported club sport. Participation may include, but is not necessarily limited to athletes, performers, managers, trainers, statisticians, and videographers. Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5. The amount of the scholarship and the number awarded is determined by the annual budget.

As of 2022, the application is digital. We recommend that you prepare your answers in advance before completing the form.

#### 2022 Questions:

- List your Athletic/Team participation while at West Springfield High School. Include participation at other high schools if you are a transfer student.
- · What extracurricular activities, including community service, were you involved with during your high school years?
- From the lists above, what accomplishments are you most proud of? Why?
- 500 750 Word Essay answering: How has being a student athlete impacted your life, and how do you expect it to impact you in the future?

(WSHS Nominated Scholarship. Multiple can apply!) Emily & Fred Ruffing AACA Scholarship The scholarship is presented by the Annandale Christian Community for Action (AACA). It is intended for a graduating high school senior of the Northern Virginia area, who has a disability. All qualifying FCPS students are encouraged to apply; however, priority will be given to FCPS Administrative Area II (Justice and Annandale High Schools) students. Students must plan to pursue a full-time higher education program beyond high school. Applications and all supporting documentation must be turned into Ms. Frederick, in the College & Career Center, by April 15, 2022 no later than 3:15pm. OCA-Asian Pacific American Advocates Gold Mountain Scholarship will award \$2,000 to fifteen first-gen, Asian American or Pacific Islander (AAPI) high school students who are graduating this year and will be starting college in the fall. Applicants do not need to be a U.S. citizen. DACA students or undocumented students must have a Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) to be eligible for this scholarship. **Open Door Presbyterian Church Scholarship** As part of our community service ministry work, we select local high school students to award our church scholarship annually. We would like to invite all high school students who are interested in receiving a scholarship to apply. The scholarship opportunity is open to all, regardless of church membership or faith. Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. Alpha Beta Alpha Omega Chapter Scholarship is open! The scholarship is applicable across 4 categories:

- Merit
- Financial Need
- Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)
- Historically Black College or University (HBCU)

Student must be a HS Senior either residing in Lorton or Springfield, VA or attend a public, private, or charter school in Lorton or Springfield, VA. Must have a cumulative GPA of a C+ (at least 2.5 avg) or better on a 4.0 scale. Student may apply for more than one scholarship. Alpha Beta Alpha Omega Chapter members and their families are ineligible. To request an

Generation Hope Scholarship Generation Hope's application is currently open through April 1, 2022. Generation Hope provides scholarships of \$1,200/year along with one-on-one mentoring, mental health support, case management, free tutoring, and more to young parents (both moms and dads) who are going to college in the DC metro area.
