Weekly Progress Reports

If you have registered for SIS ParentVUE and have a primary email address recorded in ParentVUE, you can receive your student's Weekly Progress Report via email. **For the 2020-21 school year, Weekly Progress Reports are scheduled to begin on Monday, October 5, 2020.** This report provides a summary of your student's grades for the current quarter. To activate the Weekly Progress Reports via email, login to your SIS ParentVUE account and verify that you have a primary email address within the system. It is listed under the "My Account" tab.

If it is blank, enter the email address where you would like to receive the progress reports, and click on "Update account." Once your email is confirmed, return to the "My Account" tab to activate and select your preferences for receiving these reports. Emails will be sent according to your selected preferences. Weekly Progress Reports for all of your middle and high school students will be included in one email. For additional help, refer to the [quick reference guide](#) for FCPS parents/guardians.

Parents can also access student grades through ParentVUE via the Grade Book tab.

Curbside Library Pickup Services

Library Curbside Pickup is available. Students can put up to five books on hold through their Destiny accounts at fairfax.follettdestiny.com. On Friday, a librarian will email student(s) that the books are available for curbside pickup on Monday. Students or parents can pick up books on Monday 11-3 by calling (703) 913-3939 and waiting in their car at Entrance One. A librarian will bring the books out to your car.
